## TO APPLY, YOU MUST BE:

- Between the ages of 15 and 30
- Experiencing barriers to employment
- Not attending school full-time
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Not in receipt of Employment Insurance
- A good team player and open to tackling issues that bridge youth, social action and the environment

## WHAT YOU GET:

- Full-time minimum wage employment & completion bonus
- Experience in animation, video production and editing
- Consultations in career development

## SUBMIT:

- A letter of application describing your reasons for applying, your work and school experience and how this project is important to your future
